Harold Walter (Rover) Davis, age 92 years and 8 months, of Knoxville, passed away peacefully on Saturday May 21, 2016, at the Comfort House in Pella, Iowa. A memorial service for Harold will be held at 1:00 P.M., on Friday, May 27, 2016, at the Winfield Funeral Home in Knoxville, Iowa with Pastor Rick Smith officiating. A private family burial will be held on a later date at Forest Hill Cemetery in Oskaloosa, Iowa.
